Those things not yet done

Isaiah 46:10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times [the things] that are not [yet] done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

How can you declare the end from the beginning, even from ancient times? When I think of Isaiah I think "Well, that is ancient times." Yet when Isaiah thought of it he probably was thinking "Whoa, way back in time, ancient times. Because if it was old for God then it must be way back in time." Okay, maybe Isaiah didn't say that exactly but we are dealing with a statement by God that is fascinating for our time. For we are indeed living in the last days.

And if so then God was speaking of things that were not yet done but things that were meant to be finished. But when? When would Gods counsel stand and when would he do all that he pleased or desired?

This is perhaps a difficult question for we know that He sent His son Christ Jesus, God with us, to proclaim the good news of the gospel. Jesus provided what we can call a Partho-Genesis or virgin way. The purity of his blood was untainted by sin and sin had no way to enter into his blood because he had a Holy Bloodline. This virgin pathway then lead a way to men's soul so Jesus could set up a wayfare or thorough fare which then allowed men access to God. Jesus provided the advocacy and that provided a methodology of being allowed into the presence of God unlike Isaiah who needed a coal from the altar to cleanse just his tongue. Man was far from pure and sin was the culprit. It polluted the house of the Lord so man was cast out and the Spiritual connection was shut down. There had to be a way to restore it but that meant rebuilding the way, the truth and the life. First the way. Jesus had to become the way. This was done by his virgin birth thus shutting out the path that lead to destruction via sin. The truth, like our conscience, was a path to our spirit man. But there needed to be a greater path in the sense of permanency so Jesus became the chief cornerstone which became the immovable rock which was meant to be from which the church was grown. Anything built apart from the rock would be based on hay, wood and stubble, or works of desire and not of spirit.

Then there was that which was of life and remember the body was dead and the connection to the spirit side of us had been severed. Our relationship to Christ was meant to establish a beachhead in the soul to stem the thoughts of the flesh which threatened to overwhelm us. Once that beachhead was established in our relationship with Christ and through the Holy Spirit and with God we could then grow in authority in the spiritual and then against all odds reestablish an anointing based on faith in the natural man, ie after the likes of the Original Adam. The only hindrance at this stage though would be a big one. That would be the work of the flesh, the body which was dead as spoken of various times in scripture. This body was under the law of sin and its strength was the law. For man had sinned and fallen short of Gods glory

and thus this law of sin had to be overcome in us.

Jesus provided the way, he gave us a beachhead, and then we had to make sure it remained established by constant battle, as in daily warfare of the spirit. This didn't come by being involved in ministry or just reading scripture. It could only come by daily communion with God and thus the enemy had his battlefield by proclaiming that we were meant to build the kingdom with works for thus we pleased God in acts of faith. Yet faith wasn't about building that kingdom on earth. That faith didn't come because we had a ministry. That faith came when we built our relationship with God and put ministry, family and other things secondary to that.

So if there were things that God needed to do then think of a big checklist because I guarantee you many things that needed to be done could be accomplished if God had a man of faith on earth. For if there was work to be done on earth it had to be done by a man who understood what faith was. That it didn't include him, man, going out and starting up a huge ministry unless that was God saying that. No, what God wanted is a man who would go out and do His will in all things. Now imagine it this way. You want to have money but sin arrives on the scene and tries to take over the story so it goes a different direction. Sin speaks to the flesh and the desire of the flesh and tries to control the flow of the spirit by the desire of the flesh. Now if the spirit touches the flesh the spirit is interrupted. But if the flesh is of sin this is the only way because the flesh is dead and there is no life there.

But if it were possible to establish a beachhead in the spirit then from there it might be possible to move out and begin to take back the soul and the dead man walking. This would require faith and hope and it would be a first for man wasn't meant to be in the flesh spiritually. It would be like being dead and alive and immune to suffering so you couldn't judge things well when it came to pain or suffering. Your body might actually be dead so that would be a freaky thought.

Anyway I am just a kid in here thinking of these spiritual advances and advantages. And God doesn't mind. We are allowed to be free and creative as we wish.

So what do we do from here. God wants men to do His perfect will but that perfect will means that we don't move into our own work. Now that sounds contradictory to the above but try to reason it out this way. I have time. And I use that time two fold. First I do that which is mine to do. Second I spend time with God in prayer and then I do that which is of God. Now if I do that which is of God to the degree that my fervency begins to change things in the spiritual then God can begin to change things in not just the spiritual but then on earth. And on earth is the key to this story for you and I. Now I know that we are burdened by spiritual evil and evil being part of sin, is the spiritual part that destroyed our connection to God. But we see and think in the natural and most don't even believe in God. Though that will change, trust me on that. No this change in the natural begins after we see those changes in the spiritual. We begin to have the wilderness moved out of the way. Like a huge highway being built not just over the mountain but across all hills and valleys. For when you finally do get on the train its like "Murder she wrote" for you find all kinds of skeletons and bodies strewn along the tracks and underneath the wheels. People ground into the ground because of the ministry which ends up killing them because of the pressures. The joy of the Lord seems absent all too often.

So in the middle of this super highway are train tracks. What does this mean? It means that God is building it, the tracks for when the trains start pulling into the station. You'd better get ready because the trains are going to start coming in on time. And when they do you'd better be prepared for a quick trip. For you'll arrive at your destination in super fast time and when you get there you'll find that the way has been prepared and all the things you need are ready. You'll find it not only ready but the Holy Spirit is even now softening the crowd so you will have witness after witness after witness to say that God moved in a miraculous way. It won't be a little revival you'll see but a huge one. And you'll think "That was wild" and go on to your next appointment only to find the second one is even bigger.

So lets get something straight people. You are in for the wildest ride of your life. You are going to see miracle after miracle after miracle in your life. And you will see that God isn't slow concerning His promises. That they will be heard and answered in a day. And when God gets on the Gospel train, and He will, then you will see God move heaven and earth itself to make sure that all your prayers are answered. For every spirit in all the Universe will know that Earth is the destination if they want to meet with God. And those of you who have doubted or been afraid listen up

"I God of all time and all things am coming to earth. And I am building this super duper highway. And I do use the word duper for I will make sure the enemy cannot infiltrate it. Now listen carefully men of earth. I am coming. And I am coming with 10,000 plus Saints who want to be here to witness the opening of the way. And the way has been closed down for repair for such a long time no one knew it. It is coming to a place near you. And it will change your life in such a way you will be so excited you won't be able to be still. And it will come to you so you cannot stop it. Don't try because there are bulldozers for sleepyheads like you to keep you running for your life. And if you doubt this look for a sign. A miracle coming to a home near you."
