

## When Liberty Rings Freedom Takes Wing

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord [is], there [is] liberty.

Who of us can say that we have been swallowed up in victory? Are we not the dead? Are we not those who have fallen into the cleft in the shadow of death? We have been covered there by the blood of Christ that we might find freedom even if it seemed we were caught under the weight of that rock. For that Rock is Christ and He is the chief corner stone. And there is no other rock but him in which we can trust to bring us to liberty.

For the Spirit of the Lord is upon me to proclaim liberty to the captives. To set free those who have been burdened. To proclaim to the nations that a man has risen up from the slum heap of time. And that I am a man and not a mouse ready to be jerked into the traps and snares and nets of the evil ones. For there are spirits of this world who have trapped me in a net called Time. And there I was captured and robbed of my sight and my insight and my knowledge. I was taken away from God in my heart even though I served him. I did not forsake Him and He did not forsake me. Yet I could not hear Him and I was broken hearted. I became like a broken spirit that is seen in the shadows and I could not be found among the wealth of this world. I could not be found in the power of this world. I was torn into pieces for the sake of the gospel and I put my heart into those things. I turned to the Lord with all my heart and I sought for the solace of God in my every prayer. I turned to Him that I might be found of Him. I turned my heart towards His thoughts that I might capture a stray thought. And yet I was imprisoned within my own thoughts. And I was held captive in suffering and pain. And those of my own household held me in like manner for they too were robbed as I watched of their strength and their source of strength.

That power did not come from the men of medicine. It did not come from the power of men's words or their strength in service. It came because God had set a course towards me from the far reaches of time that I might see at the end those who were set captive might be set free. For those in Hell were preached to by Christ but they were held captive in a space called the Grave.

They were in the Grave and yet they were in Hell. And that is the mystery of the Grave for those who were righteous were also held in the Grave yet were in Paradise. Some would say that they were held captive in a place separated by an abyss and yet that abyss was of the body. The body is the body of the Lord but the Lord was not the body of the mind. For the mind is the worst place you can visit in all the universe if you are part of Sin.

Now if we were to look at the facts of this story it sounds like we are saying Hell and the Grave and Death and Paradise are in the mind. But lets say that the body we speak of is not of men but of God. For of God all things consist and by Him all things have their being. So our life and our lifelines and our thoughts are all part of this connection we have with God. Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid [his] face from you, that he will not hear.

Your sins are the iniquities. Your sins are the faults and failures of giving in to sin. Now as a believer I spent time in what I can call the hell of the mind where I fought against sin. While I did so it were as if I were part of the captivity of which Christ spoke. Those who had been imprisoned in these things and yet somehow had not found a way of escape. Now this sounds strange for the Bible indicates that many dead men appeared after the return of Christ from the grave. Yet if this is so could it be possible that some did not? I believe this could be true and if so it means that there was a battle for souls and the hearts of people in the Grave. And that abyss we speak of is a place but also a reserve if you will. The reserve is a world that is held apart by a mirror. On one side is darkness, suffering and sorrow for they are separated from God by their sin. On the other hand is Paradise. They can see and speak with each other to a degree but the qualities of Sin are kept on the other side of the mirror. Now if that mirror were broken then there would have to be someone like Jesus who bore the breaking of it. And that breaking of it would then result in Sin being carried up to heaven for judgment along with all the spirits with him. This would include the Devil and his angels and Death and so on. Now if this is to happen then it would have to happen either during the time of Christ or after wards. If it happened in our day that means that we men must play a part in this somehow. And that role could be what gives the Antichrist his power. Not just in the physical but in the spiritual. Paul spoke about seeing through that dark glass and the things he saw there were forbidden to speak of. We've always assumed he saw the third heaven. But what if that mirror that keeps them separated is really a mirror we'll call the land or place of justice. A cold world that cannot be breached or overcome. If it were real, and I believe it is, then it, the mirror would be its own world. So in a way you would have three heavens to speak of. One would be hell and hell would be the sin creation. Second would be Mirror and it would be affected by Sin but indirectly so it became a barrier of the heart. And third is Paradise and Paradise became part of the world we'll call Earth. Now if this sound strange hold on.

Each place that God creates is meant to be for the souls that wish it. If you desire Joy, Love and Peace then your heart is mirrored towards Paradise and

the things of God. If your heart is mirrored towards hate, anger, death and so on then there is a realm called Hell. Now the two places, Paradise and Hell still exist. Are they still filled? Only to be separating grounds. Which means yes.

Now the Bible is filled with mysteries beyond number but all mysteries have a source of understanding if we search for the things of God. In this case the Bible tells us that Death and Hell shall rise up to give up the dead so that they can be judged. Bringing them up speaks of several things. It speaks of their being plagues upon the earth but it also speaks of something bringing up that which has been separated by a dark mirror or glass. If that Dark Mirror were to break that could be an answer but it would be one that wouldn't make sense. It would simply mean that good and evil would mix and that doesn't seem like an act I want to be around to see. But what if that Mirror were a world and that world carried Time with it. And that world was the one thing that needed healing so that the curse of Time would be no more. For if Time were part of this story and it is, then this Mirror world might have a name. It could be called Mer which means Sea. And if Hell and death are cast into the sea then that sea would have to be a place of liberty or victory for death would then be swallowed up in victory.

There is a saying among men that they will serve God when hell freezes over. What if that were to be true? What if Just Ice or Justice refers to that measure of hell freezing over? You would laugh and say "Its unscriptural because the scripture says they will be thrown into the lake of fire." So what is that lake of fire? Burning magma? Trust me if God says its a lake then that means its a lake and if its a lake then it must be of water which is H<sub>2</sub>O. And H<sub>2</sub>O is water. That still doesn't explain how it could be a lake of fire. So lets say God had a sense of humor and heard that threat of men not to serve him until hell freezes over. The fire would bring them to the light but the weight of their iniquities would carry them down again into the depths where they would be part of hell frozen over again in deep darkness and pressure. Sounds like fantasy but hang on.

If the mirror world or mer, the world of the sea, were caught up in Sins curse they would have been carried away into the weight of that abyss but the separation of justice would be the mirror of their own heart. It is there that God would use them to stand between that which was of God in love and hope and that which was of hell which was of despair. If we study scripture there is something we can learn from Truth. Truth is our conscience who speaks to us in soft whispers of the heart. She, like Wisdom, sounds like a small thing. A small thing is something that doesn't try to take control. Wisdom likes ants. Truth likes truth. And if we men wish to learn the truth of God we have to give heed to that conscience for if we heed carefully the truth will lead us to a bridge. That bridge is the cord of life. The cord of life is meant to be the silver cord which give us breath so that we are sustained.

The closer we come to it the longer we can live for on this side of the heart Sin reigns but on the other side of the heart God reigns. Now there are depths to that but the bridge is like the chasm from which it seems there is no way up. The broad way is what the masses do for they like lemmings ignore the voice of truth and follow each other into the depths of that abyss.

But there is coming some changes. And among them is the fact the the weight of the mass of Time is coming to an end. And end means that it is no longer going to weigh Justice in the balance. Part of the reason I say that is justice is being cast off as evil and yet they were created to become the justice that holds the balance. Yet Time intervened and in a way blinded justice to the Truth. For Truth was meant to see just as we were meant to understand the things of God. But we got lost when our heart was stolen by Sin at birth.
